Biotalys' crop and food protection agents target both pre- and post-harvest applications to support the move towards safer, more sustainable food production.

"There is an urgent need for more sustainable food production, and we are honored that *Fast Company* recognizes the tremendous importance of evolving food protection practices," **said Luc Maertens**, **Chief Operations Officer of Biotalys**. "Powered by its technology platform, Biotalys is creating a broad pipeline of antibody-derived biocontrol solutions to effectively and safely address key crop pests and diseases across the whole value chain – from soil to plate. This great honor strengthens our team's resolve to continue to build and develop our pipeline of transformative biocontrol solutions."
